Dear Mr Chapman

**Re: Clearance of PX-24 (GT-85), Formulation Reference GDN95367A, for Submarine Use**

You recently supplied information to the Institute of Naval Medicine on the above material that complies with the technical requirements of Def Stan 88-10, Issue 5.

The material has been assessed in accordance with the Navy Document BR 1326 and has been cleared for use in submarines (assessment ref number A3608). Obviously if there is any change in the formulation of the material it will be necessary to reassess the product. Please note that this assessment was purely on Health and Safety grounds and no assessment was made against compliance with the Defence Standard. The assessment only applies to non-aerosol packages as aerosols are prohibited for submarine use.

As any future procurement of PX-24 will require that clearance of the proposed material against BR1326 has been obtained, it would be useful to retain this note on file and to retain the reference number of the clearance. I do not have any information on likely future requirements for this product and any such enquiries would have to be directed to the DFG at West Moors.

If there are any other queries, I will be pleased to try to answer them.
